Floriade and NightFest are at Commonwealth Park in Canberra.

In this part of the guide the information is the same for both events.

Parking



You can drive your car and park nearby.



There is parking for people with disability permits.

Drop off and pick up points



There is a drop off and pickup point at Regatta Point.

It is off Commonwealth Avenue.



There is a drop off and pick up point at the Parkes Way footbridge.

It is off Allara Street. You need to walk over the footbridge.

At these points:



- You can get dropped off by your driver
- You can get picked up by your driver

Floriade Shuttle Bus



You can catch the shuttle bus to Floriade.

The shuttle bus is free.

The shuttle bus



- has an accessibility ramp
- has a low, flat floor

The shuttle bus can pick you up from and drop you off in:



- City centre, Civic
- National Triangle, Parkes
- Floriade, Regatta Point gate

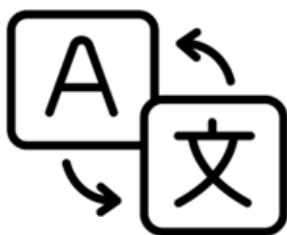
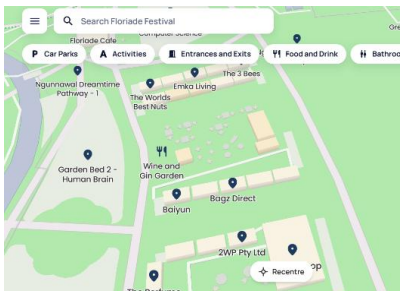

Changing Places Facility



There is a **Changing Places facility** at Floriade.

- is for people who need help to use the toilet
- has more space to move around
- has items to help people use the toilet.

Sensory Supports

There is a sensory friendly space at Floriade. It is a calm space to sit and rest.

Sensory hour is from 9:30am to 10:30am on weekdays at Floriade.

It does not run on public holidays.



During sensory hour there is less sound.

This helps people with sensory needs.



You can hire headphones to reduce sound at Floriade.

You can get them from the Information Hub. They cost \$10 to hire.

Accessibility Ambassadors

There are trained staff and volunteers who can help you with

- support you need
- adjustments you need
- hidden disabilities.

They will wear this pass. It lets you know they are an Accessibility Ambassador.



Assistance Animals

You can bring your **assistance animal** to Floriade.



An assistance animal is trained to help you with a disability.



Assistance animals must have a lead on all the time.

Tickets



Most of Floriade is free.

Some activities need tickets.

You need to buy a ticket for NightFest.

Companion Card

To use your companion card, you must buy your own ticket first.

You must email us to ask for a companion ticket at events@act.gov.au

In the email you must send us

- The name of the person that bought your ticket
- The email address used to buy your ticket
- A photo of your companion card

We will then email the companion ticket to you.

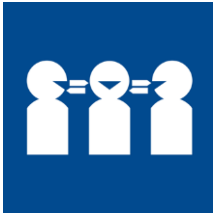
Staff and volunteers can help you at Floriade and NightFest.
